Mr. George Christopher (Chris) Lance, age 77 of Griffin, passed away on Tuesday, May 20, 2014 after complications of Alzheimer's disease at Reliance Healthcare.

He was also a former member of the Griffin Bulldog Club and the GA Poultry Federation.
