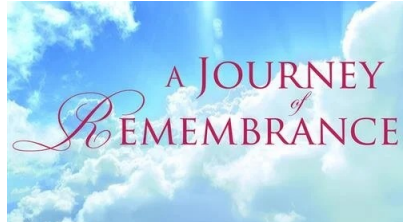

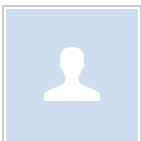
“ Aunt June,

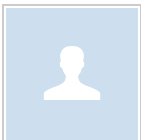

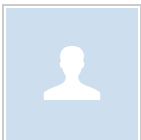
