Robert Joe Eubanks Sr went to heaven on April 26, 2009. He was surrounded by family with love. He celebrated his 75 birthday at home on April 22, 2009. Bob is survived by his wife, Dorothy R. Bob while at Griffin High excelled both at track and football. He went on to receive an athletic scholarship from Georgia Tech where he played football and graduated with a Bachelor of Mechanical Engineering.

Bob was an outstanding business leader and civic contributor to Griffin and Spalding County for many years. As president of Randall and Blakely Ford, he was one of the leading Ford dealers in the area. He was one of the innovators of the automobile leasing industry.

He was a member of Griffin Rotary Club for 20 years, serving as treasurer and on the Board of Directors. As was his father in law, Charlie Randall, Bob was the committee chair of the International Student Program in which Griffin Rotary would sponsor and host International students for Georgia colleges for a 1 year program. Bob also helped sponsor the Dick Mitchell Award, an annual award given each year for distinct honors.

As a coach in the Recreation Department League, he mentored girl's basketball teams and boy's football teams as well as coaching the Griffin Swim Team, inspiring many young people in the area to greater athletic and personal achievements.
