



Ruby Cobb Hill

September 15, 1925 - November 23, 2011

Mrs. Ruby Cobb Hill, age 86 of Griffin, passed away on Wednesday, November 23, 2011 at her residence.

She was the daughter of Fred R. Cobb and Callie Ree Padgett. She was raised in Spalding County and dedicated her career to local government. Ruby was appointed tax commissioner in May of 1956 and served six elected terms, until she retired to care for her ailing mother. She was the first woman elected to office in Spalding County and helped to open doors for women in business and the political arena. Ruby was always available to give a helping hand to family, friends and neighbors. She was preceded in death by her loving parents, older brother Fred Ellis Cobb and beloved husband Al Hill. Ruby's passing is a loss to her friends and family.

She is survived by her brother, Bobby Cobb and his wife Shirley Cobb of Sugar Hill, GA; niece Connie Belling, her husband Don Belling and their sons Jason and Ryan Belling; nephew Robert Cobb, his wife Kelly Cobb and their sons Alex and Adam Cobb; nephew Randy Cobb, his wife Lynne Cobb and their daughters Lindsey, Rachel and Sarah Cobb.
